TOP 100 NEW WAVE SPANISH WINE AWARDS 2010



"Spanish wines, like Spanish food, is getting more exciting every year, with a host of new regions emerging to support established classics such as Rioja, Ribera del Duero, Jerez and Penedés. The sixth year of the New Wave Spanish Wine Awards will put the best of Spain in the limelight." **Tim Atkin MW**

Tim Atkin MW and a panel of 16 world class wine experts (wine writers, buyers, consultants, restaurateurs and sommeliers) judged the 6th annual New Wave Spanish Wine awards. Out of over 1000 entries, 6 wines from the Liberty Wines portfolio were selected as part of their top 100.



Las Rocas Garnacha 2008

Sourced solely from 35-40 year old vines planted on vineyards up to 1200m above sea level in the region of Calatayud. This wine has intense aromas of cherry and raspberry and is bursting with ripe fruit and freshness on the palate. This is modern, great value Spain at its best.



Abadia Retuerta Selección Especial 2007

The Abadia Retuerta winery is located in the heart of the 'golden mile' of Ribera del Duero. Made from 75% Tempranillo, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Merlot, this wine is full, velvety and well balanced with long-lasting flavours of cassis, cherry and strawberry and notes of spicy oak on the finish.



Abadia Retuerta Pago Negralada Tempranillo 2006

This 2009 Decanter Gold medal winner was aged for 24 months in fine-grained Allier oak casks with medium toast, giving a full bodied and savoury wine with an attractive herbal character and a mineral quality balancing the sweet, strawberry fruit.



Valdivia Amontillado Seco Dorius NV

Made from 100% Palomino Fino from vineyards located on the chalky Albariza soils of Jerez. This Amontillado was aged under flor and then oxidatively in 600 litre oak casks for 8 years, giving an elegant, nutty and complex wine.



Sacromonte Oloroso Seco NV

The brilliance of Valdivia lies with their Sacromonte wines, a range of unique Sherries with an indication of age of 15 years. The Oloroso displays delicate nutty notes with balsamic touches from the long years spent ageing in fine oak casks.



Bodegas Castaño Dulce Monastrell 2006

For several generations, the Castaño family has been a pioneer in the Yecla DO in southeastern Spain. This wine has intense perfumes of spicy, raisined fruit and dried fig on the nose with vanilla and cinnamon spice adding a rich sheen to the voluptuous fruit palate.
